To the Members.

Gentlemen—

It is again the pleasure of your Council to submit the Annual Report and Financial Statement for the year ending July 31, 1920.

The year under review has been for this country and the world generally a period of reconstruction and settling down after the World War.

Unfortunately all-round peace has not yet been attained. Bolshevism is still rampant in Russia and Eastern Europe: and the outlook is even yet very obscure. In Ireland to-day we see anarchy and the nursing of imaginary grievances, some of which undoubtedly existed in the past, being fomented by a certain class to embarrass the Empire.

To Great Britain and Scotland, however, no greater tribute can be paid than the recognised success of their efforts to re-establish and better the conditions of pre-war life. We in Australia have our own problems to face. Let us therefore individually, as the representative Scottish Society in S.A., set our minds on the great task before us of building up the resources and population of Australia, so that she may take her proper place among the great nations of the world.



During the evening opportunity was taken to bid the Governor (Sir H. L. Galway) farewell, on his departure from Australia, and to bestow on him the privilege of Hon. Life Membership of the Society.

Mr. C. E. Owen Smyth, who was present as the representative of the Society of St. George, was also wished "bon voyage" on the eve of his departure for England.

**Scholarship.** The Muirden Scholarship was awarded to Jean Martin, who has made excellent progress. It was decided to hold in abeyance for this year the other scholarship available at Scotch College.

**Returning Soldiers.** During the year the following members were welcomed home:—Messrs. J. G. Duncan-Hughes, D. J. Amos, Coombe, Duncan Fraser, and Robinson. All our members are now back, and the Council extends its congratulations to all those who have returned safely. The memory of those who fell in France, Gallipoli, and Palestine will ever be held in reverence by the members of the Society.

**New Branches.** At Clare a very flourishing branch was established in February last. Several of our members journeyed to Clare to assist in the installation by Past Chief McEwin of the Chief of the Clare Society.

At Broken Hill a branch has just been formed, and its first meeting of members is called for August 10.

To both these new societies are extended our very best wishes for a prosperous future.

**Retirement of Secretary.** Mr. Young found it necessary through pressure of business to resign last April. The thanks of the Council and members are due to him for the enthusiastic and efficient way he always handled the affairs of the Society during his long term of office. Mr. A. B. Harvey was appointed to fill the position.

**Visit of H.R.H. the Prince of Wales.** Members of the Society, with the Pipe Band in the lead, formed a strong post at the corner of Angas and King William Streets on July 12, the day of H.R.H.'s arrival in Adelaide, to extend a fitting welcome to our future King.

On July 13, the Chief and Secretary of the Society, and the President of the Lothian Club, attended at Government House and presented an address of welcome from the joint Societies to H.R.H.

On July 17 the Pipe Band journeyed to the Outer Harbour and helped entertain the sailors on H.M.S. "Renown."

A Social Evening was held in the Co-operative Hall on July 1, and was attended by some 180 members and friends. The Chief and Mrs. Hill were present, and it was largely due to their kindness that the fixture was so enjoyable.

To Mr. and Mrs. Low, who arranged the evening, and to Mr. and Mrs. McLachlan, who were good enough to supply the music for the dances, our warmest thanks are due.

**Scottish Flags.** Representations, which it is hoped will be successful, have been made by this Society to H.M. the King, through the Colonial Secretary, to have the Scottish Flag displayed on the public buildings on St. Andrew's Day.

**Building Fund.** The amount to the credit of this fund is now £482 10s. 10d. A further effort to increase the amount is under contemplation, and members are asked to do all they can in aid of the project when appealed to.

**Chief and Council.** Mr. W. J. Hill has carried out the duties of Chief during the year with his customary zeal and tact. It is necessary to elect a Chief, five Directors, Treasurer, and two Auditors, and the following members have been proposed:—

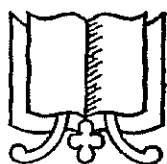
