To the Members.

Gentlemen—

The Council has pleasure in submitting for your consideration its Annual Report on the activities of the Society for the year ending July 31, 1921.

It was hoped when last year's report was compiled that the year just finished would have seen the settling down of the Empire to its accustomed tasks, so thoroughly disorganized by the war. Unfortunately, as far as industrial peace is concerned, it has proved a very difficult matter. Unemployment exists very largely throughout the world at present, and in our own State of South Australia a very large number of men of Scottish descent are continually applying to the Society for assistance. The lack of funds, however, makes it impossible to help these applicants, many of whom are certainly deserving of help.

It is suggested that members of the Society needing employees might notify the Secretary, with a view to helping a "brother Scot" along.

With regret we have to record the death of  
**Membership.** the following late members: D. Drysdale, D. Fotheringham, and A. Leitch. During the year twenty-nine new members were elected. The membership roll now stands as under:—

A large number of members who had apparently lost all interest in the Society, and whose subscriptions were hopelessly in arrear, were struck off the roll.

Is in a very flourishing condition, **Bairns' Dance Class** one hundred bairns now being enrolled. The class is in charge of a Committee consisting of Messrs. J. Ogg, J. U. McPherson, J. Thomson, E. H. Tassie, Lloyd Raggatt, C. P. Miller, and W. McLennon, assisted by Mr. W. Low and Miss Jessie McKinna, and Miss Bessie Boden provides the music, assisted by the Hon. Pipers. On July 7, 1921, the Bairns' Class held a social and dance in the Co-operative Hall, Angas Street, at which the Chief and Mrs. Hill were the guests of the evening. Some 250 persons were present, and a very enjoyable evening was spent. Through the kindness of several members of the Society an excellent supper was provided. The thanks of the members are due to all those who have helped to make the Bairns' Class such a success, especially Mr. Low. Owing to the numbers now attending the class, it has been decided to hire the Co-operative Hall on several occasions during the winter.

Was held on November 12, 1920, in the **Hallowe'en** laide Town Hall. The Chief and Mrs. Hill were again the hosts of the Bairns. The hall was well filled, and an enjoyable evening was spent. Lady Weigall was present, and addressed the Bairns, and congratulated them on their display of dancing.

Was held at the Aurora Hotel on **St. Andrew's Dinner** November 27, about sixty members and guests being present. The Chief presided, and replied to the toast of "The Caledonian Society and its Chief," given by Sir W. J. Sowden. His Excellency the Governor, Commander Braecgirdle, Past Chief McEwin, and the Rev. Donald McNicol also spoke.

The Muirden Scholarship was awarded this **Scholarships.** year to Miss Mavis McMillan, and the Society's Scholarship at Scotch College to Master Ken Laught, both of whom are making good progress.

The amount to credit is £534 1s. 4d. It was **Building Fund.** hoped to increase this considerably during the past year, but owing to the financial stringency it was decided to hold over any further appeal for funds until more propitious times.

The Chief, Mr. W. J. Hill, has borne **Chief and Council.** the responsibilities of the position with zeal and tact, and has been admirably supported by Mrs. Hill. Mr. Hill, who has been Chief since 1918, is not seeking re-election, and Chieftain D. Fraser has been nominated in his stead.

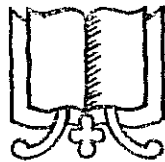
